Girl in a Cottage Garden by Isa Jobling (1851-1926)



Isabella (Isa) Jobling (nee Thompson) was born in Newcastle and studied there, at the School of Design, before going on to study art in Paris. In 1892 she began exhibiting at the Royal Academy. She also exhibited at the Bewick Club, the Royal Scottish Academy, and with the Royal Society of British Artists. In 1893 she married the artist Robert Jobling and together they lived in Whitley Bay. They were important members of the artist's colony at Cullercoats, near Newcastle.

They regularly visited Staithes and were also soon accepted as part of the Staithes Group of Artists.
