



OBS is a stream deck, receiving multiple inputs of various types to create “scenes” comprising one or more of inputs. The combined view forms an OBS Virtual Camera output provided as input to Zoom or Skype.

The Virtual (combined) Camera image appears as a single contributor to the meeting.

Up Deck is a separate piece of software that interfaces with OBS that has simple button controls that are programmable with OBS instructions. At the click of an on screen button, different scenes can be instantly switched to. It may be a single camera, a camera wall or a video to play.

Up Deck on the mobile is simply a remote but local mirroring of the button controls on the main tablet which in turn control OBS.

The mobile phone has the advantage that the user does not have to be with the laptop. Control can be elsewhere, away from whatever action there is (such as the use of a piece of equipment).
